The magic moment has evaporated, and Mr Moritz is left standing there, his head flowerless. Wolf Biermann, born in Hamburg in 1936, is a German singer-songwriter, poet and dissident. In 1953, he moved to East Germany and started publishing his first songs and poems in 1960. In 1965, his sharp criticism of the country's one-party dictatorship resulted in his being banned from performing or publishing his work, and in 1976, while in West Germany, he was stripped of his citizenship and forbidden from re-entering the GDR. His expatriation triggered huge protests in both East and West Germany. Biermann has been awarded numerous prestigious literary prizes.
